

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the General Telephone Company of the Southwest is presently furnishing telephone service to the newly incorporated City of Beach City; and

WHEREAS, the customers of the General Telephone Company of the Southwest at Beach City are receiving Baytown, Shiloh, Tri-City and Highlands local exchange service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the right of the General Telephone Company of the Southwest to earn a fair return on the fair value of its property devoted to the rendition of local exchange telephone service to its customers in Beach City, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the General Telephone Company of the Southwest is hereby authorized to continue in effect the following schedule of rates within the corporate limits of Beach City for local telephone service and such other charges and rates for Miscellaneous Services as are included in its Texas General Exchange Tariff:

Two Party Line Service	5.50
Extension	1.25

Section 2: That nothing in this ordinance contained shall be construed as in any manner, now or hereafter, limiting or modifying the right and power of the City Council under the law to regulate the rates charged by the General Telephone Company of the Southwest for its service within the City of Beach City, Texas.
