

ORDINANCE # 7  
BUILDING PERMIT I-A

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE NEW CONSTRUCTION OF NEW STRUCTURES TO WIT: GARAGES, RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL APARTMENTS, BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL BOAT DOCKS. NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS :

AS CONCERNING THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW STRUCTURES TO WIT, GARAGES, RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL APARTMENTS, BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, COMMERCIAL BOAT DOCKS BE ERECTED WITH PERMIT OBTAINED FROM CITY SECRETARY. APPLICATION FOR SUCH BUILDING PERMIT SHALL BE MADE UPON A FORM FURNISHED BY THE CITY. THE PERMIT FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE BUILDING PERMIT SHALL BE ( \$5.00).

Whereas, this permit is not intended for source of revenue, but that City Officials may keep abreast of developments that take place within City.

Whereas, this instrument is not intended for restrictions, of size, location, material, or method of construction, of said structure.

Whereas, the provisions of section I, of this ordinance shall not apply to the service head of the electrical outlet for power.

Whereas, this will be determined by the electrical code of standard requirements. No 6 T.W. wire minimum, 30 inch hangout wire, bare ground rod, 8 ft. long, 3/4 inch service hookup.

Whereas, these requirements will be inspected prior to request of Houston Lighting and Power Co. for service hookup.

Whereas, this ordinance is to be enforced by the City Marshal. The monie's received from said permits shall be retained by said Marshal to defray expenses incurred by himself in performance of this duty.
