

Ordinance No. 92-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS, ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF MARSHALL AND RESERVING THE RIGHT TO CONFER THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE TO ANOTHER PEACE OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OR TO A MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Beach City presently employs a Marshall to perform peace-keeping functions within the boundries of the City;

WHEREAS, the present City Marshall has not filed for re-election to that position;

WHEREAS, the City has posted notice of an election for the postion of Marshall;

WHEREAS, no person has filed for the position of Marshall within the period allowed for filing under the Election Laws of the State of Texas as applicable to the City of Beach City;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Beach City is desirous of abolishing the position of Marshall in that it will be an unoccupied office;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS:


SECTION ONE: That the City Council hereby abolishes the postion of Marshall.

SECTION TWO: That the City Council reserves for later consideration the appointment of another peace officer in Chambers County or the appointment of a municipal police officer.

SECTION THREE: If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be illegal, ultra vires or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. All existing Ordinances and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance will become effective at such time as the present Marshall vacates this office at the end of his term.
