

ORDINANCE NO. 98-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 85-3, WHICH ESTABLISHES PROCEDURES, FEES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE EXPULSION OF WASTE MATERIAL INTO SEWAGE FACILITIES; ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES BY WHICH PERSONS CAN OBTAIN ELECTRICAL POWER TO NEW BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES ONCE FULFILLING PROPER REQUIREMENTS OF BEACH CITY AS TO SEWAGE FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Beach City, Texas is aware that there is a need for proper procedures and laws within the City as to the regulation of on-site wastewater treatment; and

WHEREAS, unregulated treatment of sewage and waste material results in harmful effects upon the health of individuals within the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare to regulate on-site wastewater treatment;

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS:

Section I. FEE AMENDMENT

Paragraph 7 is hereby amended to read as follows:

VII FEES

To erect, construct or enlarge, alter or improve any private wastewater facility or on-site wastewater sewage facilities a fee shall be established by resolution of the Beach City Council as may be adopted from time to time, and shall be charged and collected by the City.

Said fee shall cover the costs incurred in reviewing and approving the proposed plan and the inspection, provided that the facilities meet all requirements of this regulation and no further inspections are required, and said fee shall be paid into the General Fund of Beach City.

Section II REPEALING OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH .

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section III. PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM HEREOF


This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the date and time of passage by the City Council of Beach City.

November, 1998.


