VI. Discussion and possible action on Appeal from Aqua TX.

VII. Hear update from Gulf Utilities/Nerro Supply concerning their Water and Sewer Utilities in Beach City.

Gulf Utilities operates two systems in Beach City: Bayridge Subdivision and Oaks of Houston Point. Charlie Gasper, President of Gulf Utilities, updated Council on the current status of the water well issue in Bayridge Subdivision. Mr. Gasper stated that they inherited some issues with the current water well but, it is up and running again. Gulf Utilities will have to acquire enough additional land to dig a new well. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), has a one hundred and fifty foot sanitary control easement; which means there is not enough land around the existing water well to dig a new well.

Gulf Utilities reportedly also inherited some issues with the Waste Water system. The inflow and infiltration (I&I) problems are approximately at seventy percent of their goal in fixing the holes and reworking the pipe. The higher priority for Gulf Utilities is drilling a new water well.

VIII. Discussion and possible action on Regional Mutual Aid Agreement from H-GAC.

Mayor Combs read aloud the letter from Chambers County Emergency Management Coordinator, Ryan Holzaepfel offering the City the option to join the Regional Mutual Aid program through the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC).


