

**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-4**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF MCCOLLUM PARK ROAD AND STABLEBROOK DRIVE AND THE INTERSECTION OF MCCOLLUM PARK ROAD, POINT BARROW ROAD AND SADDLEWOOD DRIVE IN THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS, AS MULTI-STOP INTERSECTIONS, TO BE CONTROLLED BY STOP SIGNS; AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS AT THESE INTERSECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND MAKING AN OPEN MEETING FINDING.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Beach City, Texas, upon recommendation by the Chambers County Sheriff's Department, has determined that it is in the interest of the safety and welfare of its citizens and the public traveling upon the streets of the City that the intersection of McCollum Park Road and Stablebrook Drive be designated as a stop intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Beach City, Texas, upon recommendation by the Chambers County Sheriff's Department, has further determined that it is in the interest of the safety and welfare of its citizens and the public traveling upon the streets of the City that the intersection of McCollum Park Road, Point Barrow Road and Saddlewood Drive be designated as a stop intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, such designations are made to preserve the public safety and welfare of the citizens of Beach City.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, MEETING IN REGULAR SESSION, THAT:**

***Section 1. Findings.***

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this ordinance as findings of fact.

***Section 2. Designation of Stop Intersection.***

- A. The intersection of McCollum Park Road and Stablebrook Drive in the City of Beach City, is designated a stop intersection. Stop sign shall be erected at the intersection directing persons traveling west on McCollum Park Road to stop before entering the intersection of said streets in accordance with the statutes of the State of Texas.

- B. The intersection of McCollum Park Road and Stablebrook Drive in the City of Beach City, is designated a stop intersection. Stop sign shall be erected at the intersection directing persons traveling east on McCollum Park Road to stop before entering the intersection of said streets in accordance with the statutes of the State of Texas.
- C. The intersection of McCollum Park Road, Point Barrow Road and Saddlewood Drive in the City of Beach City, is designated a stop intersection. Stop sign shall be erected at the intersection directing persons traveling east on McCollum Park Road to stop before entering the intersection of said streets in accordance with the statutes of the State of Texas.
- D. The intersection of McCollum Park Road, Point Barrow Road and Saddlewood Drive in the City of Beach City, is designated a stop intersection. Stop sign shall be erected at the intersection directing persons traveling west on McCollum Park Road to stop before entering the intersection of said streets in accordance with the statutes of the State of Texas.

***Section 3. Authority to Erect Signs***

The City of Beach City, Texas, or its designee, after the effective date of this Ordinance, shall erect at each such intersection described in Section 2, stop signs to signal traffic at the entrance to the intersections to stop, as required by the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices in accordance with Texas Transportation Code Section 544.001.

***Section 4. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.***

All ordinances of the City of Beach City in conflict with this Ordinance and not specifically repealed herein are hereby repealed.

***Section 5. Severability.***

If any provision, section, sentence, clause, or phrase of the Ordinance or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances, if for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, or invalid or for any reason unenforceable, the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intention of the City Council of the City of Beach City in adopting and of the Mayor in approving this Ordinance, that no portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by an reason or any unconstitutionality or invalidity of any other portion, provision, or regulation.

**Section 6. Penalty.**

Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with Section 1-5 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Beach City with a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

**Section 7. Publication.**

Publication of this Ordinance shall be made two (2) times in the official publication of the City of Beach City, Texas, after final passage, which publication shall contain the caption stating in substance the purpose of the Ordinance and the penalty for violation thereof.


**Section 8. Effective Date.**
