

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-03

AN AMENDMENT TO THE OFFICIAL STREET MAP TO RENAME MCKINNEY ROAD TO MCCLELLAN ROAD AN ORDINANCE RENAMING “MCKINNEY ROAD” TO “MCCLELLAN ROAD”, REQUIRING THAT THE “CITY STREET MAP” BE AMENDED TO REFLECT THIS CHANGE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Beach City has evaluated a request for the renaming of “MCKINNEY ROAD” to “MCCLELLAN ROAD”, to more appropriately reflect and designate the characteristics of such street within the City; and

WHEREAS, all public notices have been published, mailed and provided in accordance with statute and the City Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has conducted a public hearing on such request, in the time and manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Beach City deems it in the best interests of the citizens to rename “MCKINNEY ROAD” to “MCCLELLAN ROAD”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BEACH CITY, STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the Beach City hereby approves the renaming of “MCKINNEY ROAD” to “MCCLELLAN ROAD “for its entire length.


SECTION 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part of provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the Beach City, Texas, declares that it would have passed each every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.


SECTION 5. NOTICE. The City Secretary shall give notice of the enactment of this Ordinance by promptly publishing it or its descriptive caption and penalty after final passage in the official newspaper of the City; the Ordinance to take effect upon publication.

PASSED AND APPROVED on first reading with a quorum present, by an affirmative vote of a majority of Councilmembers present, on this 24th day of July, 2018.


