

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE MAIL BOX POLICY OF CHAMBERS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT PURSUANT TO THE REVISED COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER NO. 17-03-168 DATED MARCH 28, 2017, ESTABLISHING AND PRESCRIBING VARIOUS SETBACK DISTANCES FOR DIFFERENT TYPES OF MAIL BOXES SITUATED ALONG CITY STREETS WITH BEACH CITY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, Beach City has numerous roadways and streets within its city limits where mail boxes may be fixed to receive mail from the US Postal Service; and

WHEREAS, Beach City is concerned as to the health and welfare of its citizens when driving on and over the streets with the city limits; and

WHEREAS, Beach City is concerned with maintenance of the function, maintenance or operation of the City roadway system; and

WHEREAS, Beach City has become aware of the need to establish and prescribe setback distances of mail boxes along city streets to better prevent accidents and collisions with mail boxes and to maintain the function, maintenance or operation of the County roadway system; and

WHEREAS, Beach City wishes to establish the Mail Box Policy adopted by the Chambers County Commissioners Court pursuant to the revised Commissioners Court Order No. 17-03-168 dated March 28, 2017 establishing and prescribing various setback distances for different types of mail boxes situated along city streets; and

NOW THEREFORE; THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACH CITY, TEXAS HEREBY ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE:


SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of BEACH CITY hereby adopts the Mailbox Policy adopted by the Chambers County Commissioners Court pursuant to the revised Commissioners Court Order No. 17-03-168 dated March 28, 2017 establishing and prescribing various setback distances for different types of mail boxes situated along city streets a copy of which policy is attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes;

SECTION TWO: The City Council of the City of BEACH CITY hereby adopts the AND future revisions to the Mailbox Policy adopted by the Chambers County Commissioners Court pursuant to the revised Commissioners Court Order No. 17-03-168 dated March 28, 2017 establishing and prescribing various setback distances for different types of mail boxes situated along city streets;


SECTION THREE. Should any section or part of this ORDINANCE be held unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, or the application to any person or circumstance for any reasons thereof ineffective or inapplicable, such unconstitutionality, illegality, invalidity, or ineffectiveness of such section or part shall in no way affect, impair, or invalidate the remaining portion or portions

thereof; but as to such remaining portion or portions, the same shall be and remain in full force and effect and to this end the provisions of this ORDINANCE are declared to be severable.


