### 1. Call to order

Mayor Combs called the meeting to order Tuesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015 at 6:04 pm.  
Mayor Combs offered prayer. Alderman Colquitt led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States and Texas flags.

### 2. Public Comments (Limited to five minutes per person)

Beach City Volunteer Fire Department (BCVFD) Chief Pat McDonald gave a brief update to Council on the BCVFD's current and projected budget. They have applied for a \$25,000 Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) grant to assist with the purchase of new bunker gear. A replacement fire truck is in the planning stages. This would be a 2000 gallon tanker pumper with approximate cost of \$250,000 or more.

**5. Budget Workshop for Fiscal Year 2015-2016**

Mayor Combs stated interest rates are dropping everywhere due to the economy and the return on the City's CD's has decreased as well.

The City's permit applications have decreased this year. Council raised the permit rate charges recently.

Council discussed training and travel expenses for the City Secretary's enrollment in the Texas Municipal Clerks Certification Program and training for the Texas Municipal Court Clerk.

Mayor Combs and Council desire to have an official audit done but the cost would be high.

Council discussed not continuing the flood insurance for the City office due to high premiums that are predicted to rise even higher this coming Fiscal Year (FY).

The proposed budget will include funding for the Bridgehaven Children's Advocacy Center, and the City's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration.

Estimated income for FY 2015-2016 is \$117,959.


