

BLAKELY BOROUGH
ORDINANCE NO. 10 OF 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF BLAKELY BOROUGH ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADDRESSES ON RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES WITHIN THE BOROUGH:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Blakely provides all types of emergency services to the residents of the Borough of Blakely;

WHEREAS, in an effort to provide the quickest and most efficient response to the residents of the Borough of Blakely, it is necessary for their houses to be properly addressed; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of public safety and health to have all homes on the roads in the Borough of Blakely properly identified for emergency services.

AND NOW, therefore, be it enacted and ordained by Borough of Blakely through the authority of the same, the following:

SECTION 1:

All residential homes must have numbers that specifically identify and properly and clearly mark the home for the address given by the post office.

SECTION 2:

All existing commercial buildings must properly display a street number on the property to identify the post office given address.

SECTION 3:

New Residential Construction:

All new residential single-family homes must have numbers that are at least four inches high. Multi-family buildings such as apartments and condominiums must have numbers that are at least six inches high.

Non-Residential New Construction:

New office, commercial, retail, industrial, and other non-residential buildings must have numbers that are at least six inches high.

Color:

The color of the address numbers must contrast with the background of the location where the numbers are placed.


The address numbers must be placed in a location that can be seen from the street in both directions.

If the address numbers are placed where grass, vines or other plants can grow and affect visibility, the owner must properly maintain the growth so that the numbers are always visible. If address numbers become damaged for any reason, it is the owner's responsibility to fix them.


The Blakely Borough Code Enforcement Officer is hereby given all authority under the Borough Code to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.
