

BLAKELY BOROUGH
ORDINANCE NO. 9 of 2023

AMENDING THE ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING THE POLICE PENSION FUND OF THE BOROUGH OF BLAKELY ADOPTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL ON JULY 11, 1991, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PENSION BENEFITS FOR OFFICERS SERVING BEYOND TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Blakely previously established the Police Pension Plan; and;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Blakely intends to comply with all state regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the council of Blakely Borough, Lackawanna County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same that:

SECTION 8:

Retirement or Pension Benefits:


Section 8 of the Pension Ordinance of 1991 is amended to add the following:

- (3) A length of service increment shall be provided to all full-time police officers who retire under the terms of the existing contract in that an increment of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month for each year of completed service beyond twenty-five (25) years, provided however that said increment shall not exceed a total of \$250.00 per month in the pension benefit. The benefit is provided in addition to the already existing monthly pension benefit.


If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason determined to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, reports of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the council that this Ordinance would not have been adopted had such unconstitutional legal or invalid sentence clause or section or part thereof not been included in the Ordinance.

AND NOW, this 18th day of December 2023, upon consideration, the Ordinance above is hereby adopted.
