Regular Board Meeting

June 13, 2012

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 pm with the pledge to the flag.

Roll call showed the following members present: Hawkins, Johncox, Imm, Albain. Absent: Richardson.

Motion by Albain, supported by Imm to approve minutes of previous meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Albain, supported by Imm to approve treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Albain, supported by Imm to approve the following P.O request for window cleaning in the amount of \$125.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Albain, supported by Imm to approve payment of bills as follows: \$7,581.00 in bills paid since the last meeting. \$100,529.13 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Jack Branch gave a brief report on the lack of people complying with need to buy dog licenses and possible need to cut back on police road patrols. He also stated that Lenawee County would be passing a bill to eliminate K-2 from being sold.

Stan Sherman and daughter Kim asked if any progress had been made with Lenawee Transportation regarding picking up customers in the Onsted area, Karen Zavicar also commented on this topic. Branch stated waiting to hear more on the issue.

Gary Harper questioned progress on airport lawsuit.

unanimously.

Motion to approve resolution on medical marihuana for 6 month extension by Albain, supported by Johncox. Roll call: Hawkins – yes, Johncox – yes, Albain – yes, Imm – yes.

Motion by Albain, supported by Johncox to approve application for new liquor license for Village Restaurant new owner D. Swinicki . Motion carried. Roll call vote as follows: Hawkins-yes, Johncox-yes, Albain-yes. Imm-no.

Motion by Albain to allow fireworks permit for Floyd Rogers, Sand Lake if Rogers provided insurance and has fire department approval. Motion died due to lack of support.
