

Special Meeting Budget Workshop FEBRUARY 18, 2013

SPECIAL MEETING-BUDGET WORKSHOP

FEBRUARY 18, 2013

The supervisor called the meeting to order at 8:00 A.M.

All board members were present.

The budgets for the township for the 2013-14 fiscal year were worked on.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Garrison to authorize the purchase of a 2014 Chevy Tahoe for the police department to replace the 2008 Dodge Charger, estimated cost including outfitting will be around \$30,000, with all costs to be paid for out of the drug enforcement account. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Johncox to hire I.T. Right to host the township website and to update the site. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Gentner to increase the building and electrical permit fees to \$55.00 per inspection and to increase the payment to the inspectors from \$45.00 per inspection to \$50.00 per inspection. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to increase the rate of pay for Larry Wibbeler and Marc Brand by 2% and increase the rate of pay for Greg Hunt by 5%, and to pay overtime pay to the part-time officers who work over 8 hours per day on special events. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Johncox to eliminate the position of office manager and replace the position with a full-time secretary position and offer the position to Pat Steele. Motion carried, 4-yes, Garrison-no.

Motion by Hawkins, supported by Johncox to increase rate of pay for Brenda Imm by \$1.00 to \$13.65 per hour. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Richardson to adopt resolution establishing new sewer usage rates for the Vineyard Lake Sewer System to \$142.95 per quarter, per R.E.U. effective with the April 1, 2013 billing. Roll call vote: ayes- Johncox, Hawkins, Gentner, Garrison, Richardson; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 5:30 P.M.
