

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
SPECIAL MEETING
AUGUST 12, 2014

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 8:02 A.M.

All board members were present as well as Police Chief Larry Wibbeler.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a possible contract with Norvell Township for police coverage.

The supervisor and the police chief explained the desire of the Norvell Township board to obtain police coverage for their township on a limited basis- approximately 24 hours per week, year around. There are other jurisdictions submitting bids for this proposed coverage to Norvell.

The costs of providing this coverage was discussed as well as the need to make one of the part-time positions a full-time position if Cambridge gets this contract.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Gentner to submit a bid to Norvell Township for the 24 hours per week coverage at a cost of \$40.00 per hour. The supervisor asked for a roll call vote. Roll call: ayes-Richardson, Gentner, Hawkins, Garrison; nays-Johncox. Motion carried 4-1. Chief Wibbeler to deliver sealed bid to Norvell Township at their August 13, 2014 meeting.

There was discussion on fixing the leak in the roof at the police department as well as installing gutters. Bids are to be coming in to the township for this work.

There was also discussion about the house on Pine Street with the various zoning issues.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 8:52 A.M.
