

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
DECEMBER 10, 2014

The meeting was called to order by the clerk in the absence of the supervisor, with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call showed the following: present-Richardson, Johncox, Gentner, Garrison; absent-Hawkins.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to appoint Gentner as temporary chairman for tonight's meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Garrison to approve minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Johncox to approve payment of bills as follows: \$8,272.58 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$48,656.54 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve and place on file the monthly police, fire and zoning reports. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Richardson to approve the minutes of the October 6, 2014 and the November 29, 2014 police committee meetings. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve the minutes of the November 12, 2014 building committee meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Richardson to approve the township opting out of the requirements of PA 152 of 2011 for health insurance premium cost sharing for the year 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to table action on the application for the 2015 Tough Mudder event at M.I.S. so that all board members and the police and fire departments could be represented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Richardson to accept the letters of retirement of our two cemetery workers-Ancel Renner and Sam Ramsey-effective on December 31, 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Johncox to extend the deadline for payment of 2014 winter taxes to March 2, 2015, without penalty, to senior citizens sixty years of age and older. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Richardson to rescind the 2000 building and use restriction attached to property #CA0-108-4050 at White Lake, which will be replaced by a new building and use restriction for the newly described property at the same location. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

A moment of silence was observed for county commissioner Jack Branch, who passed away on November 17, 2014.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Richardson to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:21 P.M.
