The meeting was called to order by the clerk in the absence of the supervisor at 7:00 P.M.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to appoint trustee Gentner as temporary chairperson for the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Roll call showed the following: present-Richardson, Johncox, Gentner; absent-Hawkins, Garrison.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve the minutes of the March 11, 2015 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Gentner to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve P.O. request of fire dept. for \$479 for a saws-all. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve P.O. request of clerk in the amount of \$726.10 for a laptop and memory cards for elections. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve payment of bills as follows: \$9,705.19 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$106,546.54 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Wibbeler. Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by the clerk. Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Several firefighters were given length of service awards. They were: 5 years-T.J. Smith, Michael Herriman and Otis Garrison; 10 years-Kevin Irwin; 20 years-Jay Best; 40 years-Gary Brady and Gary Brighton; and 45 years-Chuck Schultz. The firefighters were thanked for their years of service by the board and the audience.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Gentner to approve the minutes of the March 11, 2015 building committee meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence was noted.

Dustin Brighton from the Lenawee County Road Commission presented information regarding the road funding ballot proposal that is on the May 5, 2015 special election ballot.

Donna Boglarsky gave the board an update on fund raising efforts to repair the Irish Hills Towers. Two of the grants they applied for were denied. They have one other grant request outstanding at this time. Looking into other options. The board took no action at this time.

The annual township spring clean-up will be held on Saturday, June 27, 2015 from 8:00 A.M. to Noon at the township hall parking lot.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve the schedule of meeting dates for the 2015-16 fiscal year with a change to the June meeting to June 3, 2015-one week earlier than usual. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve the list of financial institutions for the deposit of township funds for the 2015-16 fiscal year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to use the Exponent as the newspaper of record with the Daily Telegram as an additional source as needed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve contracts for road work in the amount of \$207,136.31. Motion carried unanimously.
