Motion by Garrison, supported by Gentner to approve the minutes of the July 8, 2015 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve P.O. request from fire department for 21 helmets at a total cost of \$7,455.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Johncox to approve P.O. request from clerk for the clerk's conference in September for \$650.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve P.O. requests from police department as follows: uniforms at a total cost of \$600; portable radio for \$600. Motion carried unanimously.
