REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
JUNE 3, 2015

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

Roll call was as follows: present-Hawkins, Richardson, Johncox, Gentner; absent-Garrison.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve the May 13, 2015 and the May 20, 2015 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve payment of bills as follows: \$2,178.65 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$41,913.98 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Wibbeler. Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve. Motion carried unanimously. Chief Wibbeler presented two individuals with school crossing guard awards: Kim Stark for 3 years of service and Sherri Tuttle for 25 years of service.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by the supervisor. Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Gentner to approve the minutes of the May 13, 2015 building committee meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence from the Michigan Liquor Control Commission regarding a request for an expanded Class C license for the Old Golden Nugget was noted.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Richardson to adopt resolution to renew the special assessment district for road maintenance in the Oak Hills Subdivision for a period of five years beginning in 2015. Roll call vote: ayes-Johncox, Richardson, Hawkins, Gentner; nays-none; absent-Garrison. Resolution declared adopted.

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Motion by Gentner, supported by Johncox to adopt resolution confirming the special assessment roll for road maintenance in Oak Hills Subdivision at \$90.00 per parcel for five years beginning in 2015. Roll call vote: ayes-Gentner, Hawkins, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none; absent-Garrison. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to adopt resolution of intent to renew the special assessment district for road maintenance on Marr Lake Drive and to set the hearing date for July 8, 2015 at 6:45 P.M. Roll call vote: ayes-Johncox, Richardson, Hawkins, Gentner; nays-none; absent-Garrison. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve the fireworks permit applications from Night Magic Displays for the two race weekends and the Faster Horses Concert at M.I.S. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to adopt resolution designating the township clerk as the F.O.I.A. coordinator. Roll call vote: ayes-Johncox, Richardson, Hawkins, Gentner; nays-none; absent-Garrison. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Johncox to adopt policies, procedures and fee schedules for Freedom of Information Act requests in accordance with P.A. 442 of 1976 as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:34 P.M.
