

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
MARCH 11, 2015

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call showed the following members present: Hawkins, Richardson, Johncox, Gentner, Garrison.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Gentner to approve minutes of the February 11, 2015 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Gentner to approve the minutes of the February 16, 2015 budget workshop. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Gentner to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously. The treasurer reported that the township collected 96% of taxes levied in 2014.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve the P.O. requests of the fire department for three toilets and six garage door openers. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Johncox to approve payment of bills as follows: \$8,759.85 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$37,325.63 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was reviewed by the supervisor in the absence of the police chief. Motion by Johncox, supported by Gentner to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Gentner, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to approve Tyler Mutter as a probationary firefighter. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by the supervisor in the absence of the zoning officer. Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously. Garrison inquired as to whether anyone had set up a schedule for the zoning officer to follow in covering the township. Hawkins advised that not yet, but would start on that after completion of board of review.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Gentner to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2015 building committee meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Garrison to adopt the 2015-16 budget resolution and general appropriations act. Roll call vote: ayes-Gentner, Garrison, Hawkins, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Gentner to approve the contract with Restorative Lake Sciences for the management of the Wamplers Lake Weed Control District for 2015, with Cambridge's share of the cost to be \$1,350.36, which costs to be borne by the special assessment district set up for that purpose. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received. A question was asked why the Irish Hills Towers were not on the agenda as originally indicated. It was explained that the owner asked for another month so that more information could be ready for presentation to the board. Garrison indicated that he thought the township should be soliciting bids for demolition so that in the event that is what happens, the township would know its potential financial obligation. Motion by Garrison, supported by Richardson to solicit bids for demolition costs of the towers. Motion carried, 4-yes, Johncox-no.

The date for spring clean up was discussed. A date will be announced at the April meeting.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Garrison to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and meeting adjourned † 7:30 P.M.
