The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 11:00 A.M.

Board members present: Hawkins, Richardson, Johncox, Gentner; absent-  
Garrison.

Also present: Bruce Nickel, Larry Wibbeler, Jeff Paterson, Jeff Armstrong, Tom  
Kissel.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the current drawings and sketches of  
the proposed police department addition to the township hall before submitting  
to the architect.

Bruce was asked to chair the meeting by supervisor Hawkins. Bruce reviewed  
the current drawings and discussion was held on whether to include a  
basement. Discussion also held on the possibility of adding enough space to  
the garage area to accommodate one or two fire apparatus currently housed  
at station two. Concerns were raised about having to move catch basins and  
drain lines, access to Onsted Highway and parking. Bruce suggested that he  
would like to defer to Todd Dailey to determine if this option was feasible. Also  
want Todd to review space needs for mechanical equipment in the addition  
and whether to remove or leave in a hallway that is currently proposed.

meeting adjourned at 11:40 A.M.
