

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 11, 2017

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call showed the following board members present: Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Richardson to approve P.O. request of the fire department for \$2,746.64 to replace the computer server at station #1. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve P.O. request of the office for \$300 to replace two office chairs. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve payment of bills as follows: \$12,359.03 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$58,592.88 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by the supervisor. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence was noted.

County Commissioner John Lapham reported on county business.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution establishing a special assessment district for weed control in parts of Deep Lake for a period of ten years at an estimated annual cost of \$10,295.00. Roll call vote: ayes-Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution confirming the special assessment roll for the Deep Lake Weed Control district in the annual amount of \$140.00 per lot in the district (except the Deep Lake Rec. Park, which annual amount will be \$1,755.00). Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution to renew the special assessment district for road maintenance on Washington Lake Road in the estimated annual amount of \$2,976.00 for a period of five years. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution confirming the special assessment roll for the Washington Lake Road maintenance district in the amount of \$248.00 per lot owner in the district. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Gentner to adopt resolution to establish the special assessment district for road paving on Sand Lake Drive in the estimated amount of \$41,756.25. Roll call vote: ayes-Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to adopt the resolution confirming the assessment roll for the Sand Lake Drive Paving district for a period of ten years in the annual amount of \$327.50 per improved lot in the district and \$81.88 per vacant lot in the district. Roll call vote: ayes-Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Garrison; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve the re-determination of the street lighting special assessments for 2017 as follows: Wamplers Lake-\$23.20 per parcel; Irish Mist-\$26.50 per parcel; Sports Park Drive-\$74.81 per parcel. Motion carried unanimously.

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Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the land division request of Mac Marr for a 4-acre split off of parcel #CA0-109-1300 located along Onsted Highway. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the application for an outdoor assembly permit from Michigan International Speedway for the Spartan Race in 2018 and 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
