

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
SEPTEMBER 13, 2017

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call showed the following board members present: Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve the minutes of the August 8, 2017 special meeting and the August 9, 2017 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve the P.O. request of the fire department for \$1,000 for the township's share of the cost of a grain rescue tube. The balance of the \$3,000 cost will be covered by donations. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve payment of bills as follows: \$59,569.96 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$118,370.14 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was given by zoning officer Arnold. Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence was noted.

Under old business, the Irish Hills Towers were addressed. Donna Boglarsky indicated that most of the materials to complete the exterior repairs were on site; the work crew is expected back during the week of September 25th, with a lift due to arrive that week so that the siding and windows can be completed. Kissel inquired as to whether Donna could arrange for and pay the cost of housing the workers locally so they could avoid the 3 hours per day in travel time, and get the work completed in a few days-Donna indicated that she would check into that. Garrison again asked for a schedule for the completion. Motion by Gentner, supported by Richardson to give Donna an extension of sixty days from today's date to get things completed, with weekly updates on the progress to be provided to the township. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution of intent to establish a special assessment district for invasive weed control in parts of Deep Lake and to schedule the public hearings for same for October 11, 2017 at 6:15 P.M. Roll call vote: ayes-Johncox, Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution of intent to renew the special assessment district for road maintenance on Washington Lake Road and to schedule the public hearings for same for October 11, 2017 at 6:30 P.M. Roll call vote: ayes-Johncox, Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to adopt resolution of intent to establish a special assessment district for road paving on Sand Lake Drive and to schedule the public hearings for same for October 11, 2017 at 6:45 P.M. Roll call vote: ayes-Kissel, Garrison, Johncox, Richardson, Gentner; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve the land division request of the Marsh Family Trust for eight splits off of parcel #CA0-113-1050 on Marsh Road. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the application for outdoor assembly by Michigan International Speedway for a Live Nation music festival on the fourth weekend in July for 2018 through 2022. Richardson offered an amendment to the motion, supported by Johncox to impose the same conditions on this license as were applied to the Faster Horses Concert.

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Roll call vote on the amendment: ayes-Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison, Johncox; nays-none. Amendment carried. Roll call vote on the original motion: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Motion carried.

Public comment was allowed.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:40 P.M.
