

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING  
AUGUST 8, 2018

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call was as follows: present-Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve the purchase of fifteen Automatic External Defibrillators (AED's) at a total cost of \$19,858.01 with six units going to the fire department, four units going to the police department and five units going to and being paid for by Onsted Schools. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Garrison to approve payment of bills as follows: \$14,581.19 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$76,504.28 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously. Paterson also announced that the police and fire departments would again be hosting a Camp 9-1-1 for kids on August 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>. Paterson introduced Marty Biek, a retired Dearborn Heights police officer, as the proposed school resource officer for Cambridge Township Police. Mr. Biek shared his career experiences with the board and audience. Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to create the position of School Resource Officer within the police department and to hire Marty Biek for that position. Motion carried unanimously. It was noted that the cost of this position would be shared by the township, Village of Onsted, Onsted Schools and possibly Rome Township.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by the supervisor. Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

County commissioner John Lapham reported on county business.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to adopt the resolution establishing the special assessment district for weed control in Wampers Lake at the first year projected cost of \$15,981.00. Roll call vote: ayes-Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt the resolution to confirm the special assessment roll for the Wampers Lake Weed Control District at \$116.00 per lakefront lot and \$58.00 per canal front lot for a period of five years beginning with the 2019 winter tax bill. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the land division request of Laura Merrihew for property on N. Hawkins Highway. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the land division request of Ancel Renner for property on Teachout Road. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and meeting adjourned at 7:42 P.M.
