

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 13, 2018

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call: present-Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Fire Chief Damon, Asst. Chief Armstrong and Supervisor Garrison presented several firefighters with service and educational attainment awards, with a special retirement award presented to David Rockwell after 46 years of service to the fire department.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve payment of bills as follows: \$67,363.75 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$164,699.78 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve Quintin Baker as a trainee on the fire department. Motion carried unanimously.

The clerk reviewed the monthly zoning report. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

County commissioner John Lapham gave a report on county business.

Michigan State Police Lt. Jim Jarret and representatives from M.I.S. gave an overview of the planned new traffic pattern for incoming traffic on the Thursday night before the Faster Horses Concert in July.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Garrison to approve the PA 425 agreement with Franklin Township for the conditional transfer of several parcels of land in the Gilgal Pointe subdivision between Cambridge and Franklin Townships. Roll call vote: ayes-Johncox, Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison; nays-none. Agreement declared adopted.

Stan Diroff, representing the Wamplers Lake Property Owners Association, presented a request to the board to renew the special assessment district for weed control in Wamplers Lake. Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution of intent to renew the special assessment district. Roll call vote: ayes-Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Garrison, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to adopt resolution to participate in the Inter Municipality Committee with other local units of government in the greater Irish Hills Area that would study areas of common interest such as recreation plans and the like. Roll call vote: ayes-Kissel, Garrison, Johncox, Richardson, Gentner; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Richardson to adopt resolution to increase the quarterly sewer usage rates for customers in the Vineyard Lake System to \$207.00 effective with the October 1, 2018 billing cycle. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the form of the Declaration of Restrictions that will get used in conjunction with new permits for residential secondary dwelling units, if that ordinance amendment gets approved. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Garrison to accept the lone bid received for the 2008 Dodge Charger in the amount of \$3,700.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was allowed.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:55 P.M.
