

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 10, 2018

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call of board members: present-Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison; absent-none.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the September board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the P.O. request of the fire department for \$300 for three office chairs. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve the P.O. request of the police department for \$685 for the winter Chief's conference. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve payment of bills as follows: \$193,698.90 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$289,973.69 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was reviewed by trustee Kissel. Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Asst. Chief Armstrong. Motion by Johncox, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by the supervisor. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

County commissioner Lapham reported on county business.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the redetermination of the street lighting special assessments as follows: Wamplers Lake-\$23.89 per parcel, Irish Mist-\$27.60 per parcel and Sports Park Drive-\$77.94 per parcel. These amounts will be on the 2018 winter tax bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt the resolution to collect taxes for 2018. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

The lone bid received for the 2013 Dodge Charger police vehicle of \$4,300 was rejected because it was well below the advertised minimum bid requirement of \$6,000. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to re-advertise the sale with the same minimum bid, with bids to be opened at the November meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the list of scheduled holiday office closings for 2018-19 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

Catherine Sala, candidate for the Lenawee Probate Judge position, spoke to the board and the audience about her candidacy.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:28 P.M.
