The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call: present-Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the July 10, 2019 regular meeting and the August 6, 2019 special meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Two bids were received for the re-striping of the township hall parking lot-\$500 from K & B Asphalt, and \$337.60 from DMSC, Inc. Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the bid of DMSC for \$337.60. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve payment of bills as follows: \$43,081.61 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$118,391.59 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Garrison, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

County Commissioner Lapham reported on county business.
