REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
DECEMBER 11, 2019

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call: present-Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the November meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gentner, supported by Kissel to approve the P.O. request from the Clerk's office for \$1,000 to print and mail voter information cards to all registered voters in the township. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the payment of bills as follows: \$16,562.26 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$65,955.46 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was reviewed by trustee Kissel in the absence of the fire chief. Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was given by zoning officer Arnold. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve an extension to March 2, 2020 for senior citizens sixty years and older to pay their 2019 winter tax bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve the supervisor's reappointments to the planning commission as follows: Rodney Kurowski, Robert Matejewski and Cinda Shanks for three year terms ending December 31, 2022; and the reappointment of Tom Kissel and Rick Streams to the zoning board of appeals for three-year terms ending December 31, 2022.
