

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP  
SPECIAL MEETING  
DECEMBER 17, 2019

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 A.M.

Present: Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison. Also present-Fire Chief Scott Damon.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss possible marihuana ordinances.

Discussion on the five types of facilities that are allowed under state law: grower, processor, provisioning center, safety compliance and secure transporter; and whether the township wishes to allow any of these types of facilities in the township and how many. The township has been approached by an interested party to set up a secure transporter facility.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to authorize the township attorney to draft ordinances to opt-in for medical and recreational facilities to allow two (2) secure transporters and two (2) safety compliance facilities, for consideration at the January board meeting. Motion carried-4 yes, Johncox-no.

Fire Chief Damon presented the board with his recommendation that the township adopt a fire code ordinance, specifically NFPA 1, and explained the advantages to the township for the safety and welfare of residents, businesses and visitors. Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to authorize the township attorney to draft an ordinance adopting NFPA 1 with any changes as recommended by the Fire Chief, to be considered at either the January or February meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion on allowing the placement of a flagpole and five military branch markers in the 60-foot strip of land west of the cemetery. It was decided that it couldn't be done there due to being the access to the land north of the cemetery that is leased for farming.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:50 A.M.
