MARCH 13, 2019

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:03 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed. Bruce Nickel introduced Keith Woodcock as the proposed new hire for the electrical inspector position.

Roll call of board members: present-Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2019 regular meeting and the February 18, 2019 budget workshop meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the P.O. request of the fire department for \$350 for the Homeland Security Conference for the fire chief. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve P.O. request of the office for \$1,038 to update and move to the server, the operating software for the door access system. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve payment of bills as follows: \$1,828.92 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$40,608.08 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to adopt the 2019-20 budget resolution and general appropriations act. Roll call vote: ayes-Kissel, Garrison, Johncox, Richardson, Gentner; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the land division request of Jeff Updike for a 5-acre split off of parcel #CA0-130-2100 in the 12000 Block of Stephenson Road, contingent on receipt of the driveway access approval from the road commission. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve hiring Keith Woodcock as the township's electrical inspector, beginning April 1, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to adopt the resolution approving the installation of a street light at the intersection of M-50 and Twin Lakes Drive. Roll call vote: ayes-Kissel, Garrison, Johncox, Richardson, Gentner; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Public comment was allowed.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:21 P.M.
