

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
SEPTEMBER 11, 2019

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call showed the following board members present: Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the minutes of the August regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to approve the P.O. request of the fire department for \$5,000 for the township's 5% share of the \$50,000 FEMA grant for the purchase of a cascade system for filling air bottles. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve the payment of bills as follows: \$2,625.55 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$61,050.72 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson and the minutes of the September 10, 2019 police committee meeting were reviewed. Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Assistant Chief Armstrong. Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously. Armstrong also presented preliminary plans being worked on for the replacement of the chassis on Squad 10 and Rescue 11, which work will be spread over two budget years. Authorization was given to continue working on the project.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence was noted.
