REGULAR BOARD MEETING
JULY 8, 2020

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call showed the following board members present: Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the June meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the P.O. in the amount of \$2,500 for the crack filling and seal coating of the drives in Maple Shade Cemetery. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve the P.O. requests of the fire department as follows: \$90 for two name plates for fire coats, \$325 for a facepiece for an SCBA unit, \$125 for a Nomex hood and \$5,000 for the refurbishment of the inside of the box on Rescue 11. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve payment of bills as follows: \$77,348.35 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$54,332.63 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was reviewed by Kissel. Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Asst. Chief Armstrong. Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by Kissel. Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

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Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve the fireworks permit application for the Deep Lake Association for a display on July 18, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the update to the township fee schedule for such things as variances, rezoning, plats, etc. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the bid for a culvert replacement on Springville Hwy. between M-50 and Sheeler Road in the amount of \$2,783.90. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:25 P.M.
