

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MAY 6, 2020

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call: present-Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the P.O. request from the Cemetery for \$17,159.00 for a zero-turn tractor and a riding mower from Napoleon Lawn & Leisure. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to solicit sealed bids for the 2014 John Deere zero-turn tractor, and an open bid for the 2008 John Deere riding mower. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve P.O. request of the cemetery for \$2,550 to have six trees removed at Maple Shade Cemetery. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve P.O. request of fire department for \$3,162.00 for four pagers. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve P.O. requests for the office as follows: \$4,942.00 for new LED lighting to replace the current indoor lighting in the office; \$5,295.00 for an additional tabulator and ballot box for elections. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve payment of bills as follows: \$80,074.74 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$23,434.47 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Richardson, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was given by zoning officer Arnold. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

County commissioner Lapham gave a report on county business.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the schedule of meeting dates for the 2020-21 fiscal year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the 2020 fireworks permit application for the Loch Erin Property Owners Association. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Kissel to approve the 2020 fireworks permit application for the Sand Lake Property Owners Association. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to adopt Ordinance #2020-04, the International Fire Code Ordinance. Roll call vote: ayes-Richardson, Gentner, Kissel, Johncox; nays-Garrison. Ordinance declared adopted.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to adopt Ordinance #2020-03, amendments to the zoning ordinance for the placement of marijuana facilities. Roll call vote: ayes-Kissel, Garrison, Johncox, Richardson, Gentner; nays-none. Ordinance declared adopted.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve road projects with the Lenawee County Road Commission in the amount of \$176,201.22. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Johncox to adopt resolution to place the renewal of the 1.25-mil public safety operation and maintenance millage on the August 4, 2020 election ballot. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution to place a request for a .25-mil public safety building and apparatus replacement millage on the August 4, 2020 election ballot. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to adopt resolution to place a request for a.25-mil additional public safety operational millage on the August 4, 2020 election ballot. Roll call vote: ayes-Kissel, Johncox, Richardson, Gentner; nays-Garrison. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution setting fees for the operation of the cemeteries. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Reviewed the four bids received for the lawn care at the township hall. Motion by Richardson, supported by Johncox to accept and award the low bid to Adams Property Services. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to accept the low bid from Green Borders to continue the lawn fertilization and pest control applications at the township hall. Motion carried unanimously.

The two sealed bids received for the sale of the 2009 Ford F-550 chassis were opened. Both were rejected because they were about half of the required minimum bid of \$12,500. Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to sell the chassis on open bid with the asking price of \$12,500. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 8:27 P.M.
