

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 14, 2020

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 7:00 P.M. with the pledge to the flag.

Nancy Smith, candidate for the Michigan 65<sup>th</sup> House district, introduced herself and spoke to the board and the audience.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Roll call showed the following members present: Gentner, Richardson, Johncox, Kissel, Garrison.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the minutes of the September meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Garrison to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve the P.O. request of the fire department for \$859 for a 4" hose gated Siamese wye device. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve payment of bills as follows: \$18,190.97 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$63,630.36 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Johncox, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously. Chief Damon presented the names of three applicants to the board for approval: Amy Hill, Charles Bittinger and Ryan Reynolds. Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was given by zoning officer Arnold. Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

County commissioner Lapham gave a report on county business.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to concur with the recommendation of the Cambridge Township planning commission and the Lenawee County planning commission to deny the rezoning request of J&W Warner Farms for a 1.5-acre parcel on Onsted Highway south of the Village. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Richardson, supported by Kissel to adopt resolution to participate in the Greater Irish Hills Recreation Plan spearheaded by the Intermunicipality Committee, with Cambridge's cost share likely covered by the balance in the Region 2 dues account. Roll call vote: ayes-Richardson, Johncox, Garrison, Kissel, Gentner; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to adopt the resolution to collect taxes for December, 2020, as presented by the treasurer. Roll call vote: ayes-Garrison, Kissel, Gentner, Richardson, Johncox; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the renewal of the employee's health insurance plan for 2021, with a 3.08% premium increase. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johncox, supported by Garrison to approve the DeLand/Lauer land division request for a 2-acre parcel on Sheeler Road. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Richardson to approve the schedule of holiday office closings for the 2020-21 period. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Kissel to approve the Hanes/Spicer land division request for a 10+/- acre parcel on Springville Highway. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comment was received.

Motion by Kissel, supported by Johncox to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M.
