REGULAR BOARD MEETING
JULY 14, 2021

The supervisor called the meeting to order with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call of board members present: Rohrbach, Garrison, N. Gentner, W. Gentner, and Roesch.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Rohrbach to approve the minutes of the June 9, 2021 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Roesch, supported by N. Gentner to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by Garrison to approve the PO Request to purchase tactical earpiece, microphones and batteries for the fire department radios in the amount of \$3,438.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rohrbach, supported by Roesch to approve the PO Request to purchase and install a POE Switch for the server in the Township Hall in the amount of \$914.75. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Roesch to approve the PO Request to the remainder of the board room technology upgrade in the amount of \$8,130.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Rohrbach to approve the PO Request to outfit the 2021 Cruiser in the amount of \$6,339.89. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by N. Gentner to approve payment of bills as follows: \$44,159.79 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$58,180.70 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Garrison, supported by Roesch to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Assistant Chief Armstrong. Motion by Roesch, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by R. Arnold. Motion by Rohrbach, supported by Garrison to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by Garrison to approve road projects with the Lenawee County Road Commission in the amount of \$247,759.14. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rohrbach, supported by Garrison to approve the Cambridge Township Logo. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Roesch to concur with the recommendation of the Cambridge Township planning commission and the Lenawee County planning commission to deny the rezoning request of Baloor Development for a 3.19-acre section of a parcel on Springville Highway from RL1- C2. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Roesch, supported by Garrison to concur with the recommendation of the Cambridge Township planning commission and the Lenawee County planning commission to deny the rezoning request of Baloor Development for a 18.75-acre section of a parcel on Springville Highway from AG- RL1. Motion carried unanimously.

The annual audit report was presented by Brent Shea, CPA, again showing the township to be in excellent financial condition. Motion by Roesch, supported by W. Gentner to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by Rohrbach to apply for the American Rescue Plan Act Funding, giving Cambridge Township \$495,501.00 for use on specific projects that meet the Act requirements. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Roesch, supported by N. Gentner to hire Brian Lewis as a backup electrical inspector. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Roesch to sign a one-year contract for a maintenance contract for our door access system contingent on our IT department's ability to work with them, in the amount of \$689. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison supported by N. Gentner to adopt the resolution of intent for the special assessment of Vaniman Island Drive Road Maintenance. Roll Call vote: ayes- Garrison, N. Gentner, W. Gentner, Rohrbach, Roesch, nays- none. Motion carried.

Motion by Roesch supported by Rohrbach to adopt the resolution of intent for the special assessment of Marsh/Lyster Road Maintenance. Roll Call vote: ayes- Roesch, Rohrbach, Garrison, N. Gentner, W. Gentner, nays- none. Motion Carried.

Motion by W. Gentner, supported by N. Gentner to split the cost with the Lenawee County Road Commission to replace the culvert and catch basin on Kinglsey Dr. in the amount of \$2,442.33. Motion carried unanimously.
