REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MARCH 10, 2021

The supervisor called the meeting to order with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 P.M., following the budget public hearing.

Roll call of board members present: Garrison, N. Gentner, W. Gentner, Rohrbach, and Roesch.

A period of limited public comment was allowed.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Roesch to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2021 regular meeting, February 12, 2021 budget workshop and the February 15, 2021 budget workshop. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Roesch, supported by N. Gentner to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Rohrbach to approve the PO request for the Cemetery from Napoleon Lawn and Leisure to purchase a pole saw in the amount of \$479.99. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by Garrison to approve the PO request for the Fire Department from Stryker to purchase a Lucas Device in the amount of \$13,762.64, and from ML Quality Painting to paint and epoxy the floor in the amount of \$4,050.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by Roesch to approve payment of bills as follows: \$30,803.15 in bills paid since the last meeting and \$31,152.41 in current month bills. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly police report was given by Chief Paterson. Motion by Garrison, supported by Roesch to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly fire report was given by Chief Damon. Motion by Roesch, supported by Rohrbach to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The monthly zoning report was reviewed by Rick Arnold. Motion by Garrison, supported by Rohrbach to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence was noted.

Motion by Roesch, supported by Rohrbach to adopt the 2021-22 budget resolution and general appropriations act. Roll call vote: ayes-Roesch, Rohrbach, Garrison, N. Gentner, W. Gentner; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by Garrison to adopt the resolution to establish sewer rates and charges for the Vineyard Lake Sewage Disposal system portion of sanitary sewer special assessment district No. 1. Roll call vote: ayes-N. Gentner, Garrison, W. Gentner, Rohrbach, Roesch; nays-none. Resolution declared adopted.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Rohrbach to approve the 2021 fireworks permit application for the Loch Erin Property Owners Association. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner supported by Roesch to approve the 2021 fireworks permit application for the Sand Lake Property Owners Association. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Rohrbach to set Saturday, June 19th as the date for spring clean-up, at the township hall from 8:00 A.M. to Noon. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Roesch, supported by N. Gentner to approve the MTA conference attendance for 4 board members. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Roesch, supported by Rohrbach to accept, with regrets, the resignation of Mike Albain from the Zoning Board of Appeals. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Roesch, supported by N. Gentner to approve the supervisor's appointment of Rick Richardson to fulfil the vacant position on the Zoning Board of Appeals, term ending December 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Garrison, supported by Roesch to approve the land division application, #21-001, from Baloor Development for one division of 1.4 acres off of parcel #CA0-126-1100-00 located at 8875 Springville Hwy. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by Garrison to get advertise a request for bids for cleaning services for the township hall. Motion carried unanimously.

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Motion by Garrison, supported by Rohrbach to approve the prepayment of Green Borders for weed and pest control of the Township Hall grounds for the 2021 season in the amount \$1,503.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by N. Gentner, supported by W. Gentner to increase the Fire Chief salary by 2% beginning April 1, 2021. Garrison requested a roll call vote. Roll call vote: ayes- N. Gentner, W. Gentner; nays-Garrison, Roesch, Rohrbach. Motion denied.

A period of public comment was allowed.

Motion by Roesch, supported by Rohrbach to adjourn. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M.
