Special Council Meeting
July 1, 2015

Mayor Cole called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Roll Call: Present: Cole, Cox, Earl, McConn, Kenny

Public Comment – None

Old Business: Trash/Recycling – Mayor Cole gave the history on the process and explained how the trash/recycling process would work. She explained there would be an opt out process for those you did not wish to participate. There were several other comments from Council and residents after which Council decided to move forward with business on the agenda.

Ordinance #198 Garbage and Refuse Collection – Vice-Mayor McConn moved to adopt Ordinance #198. Seconded by Councilman Earl. Motion carried.

Ordinance #199 Recycling Collection – Councilman Earl moved to adopt Ordinance #199. Seconded by Councilman Kenny. Motion carried.

New Business – Approve of Revised Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Policies – Manger Heydlauff told Council to keep up with recent law changes an updated FOIA policy was necessary. Councilwoman Cox moved to adopt the new policy. Seconded by Vice-Mayor McConn. Motion carried.

Upgrade City Telephone System – Manager Heydlauff explained the city's current telephone system was rather dated and there were issues with equipment. He said he believed it to be 30 plus years old. He said he had talked with DMCI Broadband who provides the City with internet service and they offered a proposal to upgrade the handsets and covert the system to a Voice Over IP System for approximately \$3,200.00. He said all telephone numbers would remain the same and there would not be any interruption of service. Vice-Mayor McConn moved to approve the upgrade of the City's telephone system. Seconded by Councilman Kenny. Motion carried.

City Manager Comments – Manager Heydlauff thanked the residents in attendance for their comments and said he appreciated their input.

Council Comments – Council thanked those residents in attendance for their comments and concerns. They said they felt recycling was a good thing for the community but would keep in mind their concerns when drafting a contract with the provider.
