Mayor Cole called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Public Comment: Chuck Bell, representative of the Sesquicentennial committee, spoke to Council about events he would like to see take place at Bronson's sesquicentennial celebration tentatively planned for September 10-11.

Consent Agenda – Vice-Mayor McConn moved to approve the consent agenda including payment of invoices totaling \$33,646.82. Seconded by Councilman Earl. Motion carried.

New Business – Ordinance #201 – An ordinance to amend City of Bronson Ordinance 30.03 "Planning Commission" Section (B) (1) – Manager Mersman explained over the last few months it has been difficult to get a quorum at Planning Commission meetings to conduct business. He said there has been three vacancies for several months. He was suggesting amending the number of members from nine to five. He said this would make it much easier to get a quorum to conduct business. Councilwoman Cox moved to adopt Ordinance #201. Seconded by Vice-Mayor McConn. Motion carried.
