CALL TO ORDER: Carl Newton called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Motion by Smith to go out of regular meeting into Public Hearing for Smith Machine IFT, support by Kissinger. Voice vote yes. 7/0
There was some discussion on the status of personal property as well as the depreciation of personal property.

Motion by Diller to go out of Public Hearing for Smith Machine IFT and back into regular meeting, support by Kissinger. Voice vote yes. 7/0

Motion by Henson to approve tax break for 10 years because I don't have faith in what the legislature wants, support by Smith. Roll call: Yes: Diller, Kissinger, Craig Newton, Smith, Henson, Doxey, and Mayor Newton.

Motion by Smith to approve Election Workers: Larry Sackrider, Judy Soule, Stanley Chovanec, Barbara Horn, and Rhoda Haist, support by Diller. Voice vote yes. 7/0

Rob Wilson advised council that pavement marking on Burgess Drive was already done. He was not sure who had done it, or if a bill would be rendered.

Motion by Diller to give interim police chief \$1.50 total increase per hour, to be split as follows: interim police chief \$1.00 per hour, Part-time officer \$.25 per hour, and detective \$.25 per hour, support by Kissinger. Roll call: Yes: Craig Newton, Smith, Doxey, Kissinger, Henson, Diller, and Mayor Newton.

There was discussion on a tree at 127 West Battle Creek Street and whether it should be removed. Mayor Newton, Craig Newton, and Rob Wilson were going to examine the tree after the meeting and determine if it is a public hazard.

Motion to adjourn by Henson, support by Diller. Meeting adjourned at 6:30 P.M.
