

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 70.11 OF THE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, the City of Cokato has reviewed its Ordinances as it pertains to on-street Winter parking; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cokato believes that adjusting the Winter Parking Rules in the according way is best for the community;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Cokato adopts the following changes to the Ordinance.

Current Cokato Ordinance

§ 70.11 WINTER PARKING

No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle or permit it to stand on any street in the city between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on any day from November 15 through May 1, both inclusive. One parking space shall be required for every dwelling unit for a one-family dwelling or efficiency units.

Option #1

§ 70.11 WINTER PARKING

No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle or permit it to stand on any street in the city between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on any day from November 15 through **April 1**, both inclusive. One parking space shall be required for every dwelling unit for a one-family dwelling or efficiency units.

Option #2

§ 70.11 WINTER PARKING

No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle or permit it to stand on any street in the city between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on any day from November 15 through **April 15**, both inclusive. One parking space shall be required for every dwelling unit for a one-family dwelling or efficiency units.
