

ORDINANCE NO. 100-21

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CLOSING OF DEPOT STREET, BROAD STREET AND MAIN STREET FOR THE PURPOSE OF HOSTING THE CONNEAUT HOLIDAY PARADE FROM 5:00PM TO 9:00PM ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. That Depot Street, Broad Street from Depot to State Street, Harbor Street from State Street to Main Street and Main Street shall be closed on Friday, November 26, 2021 from 5:00-9:00PM for the purpose of the Conneaut Holiday Parade.

PARADE ROUTE: The parade will line up on Depot and Chestnut Street. Depot Street to Broad Street; proceed South on Broad Street to State Street (Route 20); East on State Street/Route 20 to Harbor Street; Harbor Street/Route 20 to Main Street. West on Main Street and ending at Rite Aid on Main Street.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health and safety and to allow for event planning and, shall take effect immediately upon the signing of the President of Council.



