

ORDINANCE NO. 119-21

AN ORDINANCE TO DELETE SECTION 935.03(c) – CHARGES AND RENTS GENERALLY, OF THE CITY OF CONNEAUT CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Conneaut sewerage rates are currently listed in Section 110.09 and 935.03(c) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Conneaut.

WHEREAS, having the rates listed in two places can cause unnecessary confusion and it is easier to list all City fees and charges in one section.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 935.03(c) of the City of Conneaut Codified Ordinances is hereby deleted and all sewerage charges will be listed in Section 110.19:

~~(c) On January 1, 2017 the user charges for all user classes shall be:~~

~~(1) General administrative cost: \$3.85 per month~~

~~(2) System operation, maintenance
and replacement: \$0.00512 per gallon or
\$5.12 per 1,000 gallon~~

~~(3) Debt Service:~~

~~(A) 0 – 2,000 Gallons/Month = \$ 16.25 (\$5.12/1,000 gallons)~~

~~(B) 2,000 – 20,000 Gallons/Month = \$ 6.01 + (\$3.48/1,000 gallons)
Over 2,000 gallons~~

~~(C) 20,001 – 100,000 Gallons/Month = \$ 68.65 + (2.80/1,000 gallons)
Over 20,000 gallons~~

~~(D) 100,001 – 300,000 Gallons/Month = \$292.65 + (\$2.49/1,000 gallons)
Over 100,000 gallons~~

~~(E) 300,001 – 600,000 Gallons/Month = \$790.65 + (\$1.86/1,000 gallons)
Over 300,000 gallons~~

~~(F) Over 600,001 Gallons/Month = \$1,348.65 + (\$1.22/1,000 gallons)
Over 600,000 gallons~~

~~(4) Senior citizens aged 65 or older shall be entitled to a discount against the debt service of \$2.00 per month no more than one discount per household served.~~

SECTION 2. That all other prior ordinances found to be inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health and safety and, shall take effect immediately upon passage and signing by the President of Council.
