

ORDINANCE NO. 13-23

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF CONNEAUT, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Conneaut, Ohio;

WHEREAS, numerous sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly;

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Conneaut, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to wit:

SECTION 2. The following sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes as amended, are hereby approved and adopted as amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly.

Traffic Code

337.10 Lights, Emblems, and Reflectors on Slow-Moving Vehicles, Farm Machinery, Agricultural Tractors, and Animal-Drawn Vehicles. (Amended)

337.16 Number of Lights; Limitations on Flashing, Oscillating or Rotating Lights. (Amended)

General Offenses Code

513.01 Drug Abuse Control Definitions. (Amended)

549.02 Carrying Concealed Weapons. (Amended)

549.04 Improperly Handling Firearms in a Motor Vehicle. (Amended)

549.10 Possessing Replica Firearm in School. (Amended)

549.13 Concealed Handgun Licenses; Possession of Revoked or Suspended License; Additional Restrictions; Posting Signs Prohibiting Possession. (Added)

SECTION 3. A copy of such ordinances or parts of ordinances as edited, arranged and numbered or renumbered as parts of the Codified Ordinances is attached to this Ordinance in the form of 2022 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health and safety and for the reasons that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the City, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid legal entanglements including conflict with general State law and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect upon its passage and signing by the President of Council.
