

ORDINANCE NO. 30-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 953.01 OF THE CITY OF CONNEAUT CODIFIED ORDINANCES GOVERNING FEES FOR GRAVE OPENINGS AND GRAVE PURCHASES, AND NOT DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 953.01 of the City of Conneaut Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

953.01 ~~FEES FOR~~ GRAVE OPENINGS AND GRAVE PURCHASES.

~~The following fees are established for the Municipal Cemetery:~~

- ~~a) The cost of a grave opening for a full burial shall be \$450.00 during weekdays, \$600.00 on Saturdays.~~
- ~~b) The sale price of a single grave lot located within the monument section shall be \$525.00. The sale price of a single grave lot located with the ground level head stone section shall be \$425.00.~~
- ~~c) The sale price of a single grave lot shall be \$525.00, and the sale price of special infant lots shall be \$175.00. The cost of a lot for cremains shall be \$200.00.~~
- ~~d) The cost of a grave opening for cremains shall be \$300.00 during weekdays, \$375.00 on Saturdays.~~
- ~~e) The cost of infant interments shall be \$200.00 during weekdays and \$275.00 on Saturdays.~~
- ~~f) Interments, scheduled after 2:00 p.m. shall be charged an additional fee of \$100.00.~~
- ~~g) The cost of all disinterments shall be in the sum of \$1,000 (Full), \$350.00 (Infant), \$350.00 (Cremains), to open and close a grave within the City Cemeteries.~~
- ~~h) The fees set forth above shall be paid to the Cemetery Sexton or his designated agent in advance of any service rendered.~~
- ~~i) The amount of \$100.00 per single grave lot sale, \$60.00 per cremains lot sale, and \$40.00 per infant lot sale, will be allocated to a perpetual trust fund.~~
- ~~j) A \$250.00 non-resident fee will be added to the sale of each cemetery grave lot.~~
- ~~k)a) The cost for cemetery deed transfer will be \$30.00 per transfer. Fees for the Municipal Cemetery are listed in Section 110.11 of this code.~~
- b) The City will designate specific sections within the East Conneaut and Glenwood Cemeteries where monuments shall be permitted. Said monuments shall be required to have a four inch (4") cement foundation/border. The City shall also designate areas within said cemeteries for ground level head stones.

SECTION 2. That all other prior ordinances found to be inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this

Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is not declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health and safety and, shall take effect thirty (30) days after passage.
