

ORDINANCE NO. 36-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A FEDERAL ODOT-LET PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized enter into a Federal ODOT-LET Project Agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purpose of replacing the existing pavement, storm system, sidewalks, lighting and curb ramps, as well as the existing traffic signals at the intersections of U.S. Route 20 and Jackson Street with S.R. 7 (see Agreement attached as Exhibit A).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health and safety for the reason to allow work to begin as soon as possible and, if approved, shall take effect immediately upon passage and signing by the President of Council.
