

**ORDINANCE NO. 45-22**

**AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE FUND "333 – OEPA DREDGE GRANT" FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCOUNTING FOR THE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS RELATED TO THE OHIO EPA GRANT RECEIVED FOR THE CONNEAUT CREEK DREDGE MATERIAL FACILITY.**


BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Fund "333 –OEPA Dredge Grant" is hereby created for the purpose of accounting for the receipts and disbursements related to the funds received from the Ohio EPA for the Conneaut Creek Dredge Material Facility.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



SECTION 3. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and signing by the President of Council.


