

## ORDINANCE NO. 52-22

WHEREAS, the City of Conneaut has received bids for the demolition of the commercial structure located at 970 Harbor Street, Conneaut, Ohio, and Hugh's Excavating has submitted the lowest and best bid, with a total bid price of \$16,850.00.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to award the bid and enter into contract with Hugh's Excavating for the demolition of the commercial structure located at 970 Harbor Street, Conneaut, Ohio at the total bid price of \$16,850.00.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health and safety and to allow the work to begin as soon as possible and, if approved shall take effect immediately upon passage and signing by the President of Council.
