

ORDINANCE NO. 76-21

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE THE FOLLOWING STREETS ON SEPTEMBER 24, 2021 FROM 5:00PM UNTIL 6:30PM FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CONNEAUT HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Conneaut, County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the following streets shall be closed on September 24, 2021 from 5:00PM until 6:30PM for the purpose of the Conneaut High School Homecoming Parade:

PARADE ROUTE: The parade will leave the Conneaut High School parking lot on Chestnut Street, proceed South on Chestnut Street to State Street (Route 20); West on State Street (Route 20) to Stadium Avenue; North on Stadium Avenue to Joslin Field.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interests of public peace, health and safety, and to allow for event planning and, if approved, shall take effect immediately upon passage and signing by the President of Council.
