

# Crittenden Fiscal Court / Regular Meeting

Present and presiding, Honorable Perry Newcom, Judge-Executive

Crittenden Fiscal Court met pursuant to adjournment with Judge-Executive Perry Newcom; magistrates Dave Belt, Todd Perryman, Willard Guill, Greg Rushing, Chad Thomas and Dan Wood; County Attorney Rebecca Johnson; Sheriff Wayne Agent; County Clerk Daryl Tabor; and Treasurer Yvette Martin present.

A quorum being present, the following orders were held:

Receipt of the Feb. 17, 2022, regular meeting minutes of Crittenden Fiscal Court was acknowledged with no corrections or amendments.

Receipt of the March 4, 2022, special meeting minutes of Crittenden Fiscal Court was acknowledged with no corrections or amendments.

Heidi Martin again brought before the Fiscal Court her desire to have Workman Road renamed Steve Rogers Road in honor of her father. The body refused to take another vote on the matter, as it had previously denied the request following the statutory process to consider renaming roads.

Receipt of the March 2022 Crittenden County Detention Center report reflecting 205 inmates housed at present and \$211,014.18 in revenue for the month of February 2022 was acknowledged.

Receipt of the March 2022 Crittenden County Animal Shelter report reflecting a total of 20 dogs and one cat housed at the end of February 2022 and \$1,062.31.00 in revenue for the same month was acknowledged. Also noted was a donation of 2 tons of cat litter.

Receipt of the Treasurer's Monthly Income and Disbursement Report was acknowledged as presented.

**NEW BUSINESS**

On the motion of Magistrate Rushing, seconded by Magistrate Wood, it is hereby resolved to award a bid to the sole bidder, Bear Property Development of Princeton, Ky., for Alternate 1 of an estimate to replace the roof of Crittenden County Rescue Squad headquarters for \$21,000.00. Alternate 2 to replace siding on the building for \$27,000.00 was refused. All magistrates voted for said motion. Motion carried.

On the motion of Magistrate Wood, seconded by Magistrate Guill, it is hereby resolved to approve appropriation and disbursement of \$21,000.00 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to support Crittenden County Rescue Squad's replacement of the roof at its headquarters. All magistrates voted for said motion. Motion carried.

On the motion of Magistrate Belt, seconded by Magistrate Perryman, it is hereby resolved to accept the high bid of \$510.00 from Barrett Travis for a surplus 2008 Ford Escape. All magistrates voted for said motion. Motion carried.

On the motion of Magistrate Perryman, seconded by Magistrate Rushing, it is hereby resolved to approve disbursement of four incentive payments of \$1,169.77 each for four training units for a total of \$4,679.08 to Judge-Executive Newcom. All magistrates voted for said motion. Motion carried.

On the motion of Magistrate Belt, seconded by Magistrate Thomas, it is hereby resolved to approve an amendment to Administrative Code Section 5.50 (Harassment) to include policies adopted in 2014 but omitted from the Code. All magistrates voted for said motion. Motion carried.

Receipt of the Fiscal Year 2023 proposed Jail budget was acknowledged as presented.

On the motion of Magistrate Perryman, seconded by Magistrate Rushing, it is hereby resolved to set the pay rate for Early Voting election workers at \$100.00 per day. All magistrates voted for said motion. Motion carried.

Judge-Executive Newcom updated the Fiscal Court on progress at the county's eventual new home for government offices, with construction starting in earnest on this day and the delay on steel for the new construction down to only four months.

On the motion of Magistrate Perryman, seconded by Magistrate Rushing, it is hereby resolved to adjourn Crittenden Fiscal Court until the regular meeting scheduled for 8:30 a.m. Thursday, April 21, 2022, unless sooner called to meet by Judge-Executive Newcom.
