



Update: Flood Advisory issued May 8 at 1:59PM MDT until May 9 at 6:00PM MDT by NWS Boise ID

Adams, ID; Boise, ID; Camas, ID; Elmore, ID; Gem, ID; Payette, ID; Valley, ID; Washington, ID; Baker, OR

\* WHAT...Small stream flooding caused by rain and snowmelt continues.

\* WHERE...Portions of southwest Idaho and northeast Oregon, including the following counties, in southwest Idaho, Adams, Boise, Camas, Elmore, Gem, Payette, Valley and Washington. In northeast Oregon, Baker.

\* WHEN...Until 600 PM MDT Tuesday /500 PM PDT Tuesday/.

\* IMPACTS...Minor flooding in low-lying and poor drainage areas.

Rises in small streams and normally dry arroyos. Water over roadways. Overflowing poor drainage areas.

\* ADDITIONAL DETAILS...

- At 158 PM MDT /1258 PM PDT/, Continuing snowmelt along with additional rain tonight and Tuesday morning will cause small stream flooding. Overflowing poor drainage areas will cause minor flooding in the advisory area.

- Some locations that will experience flooding include...

Baker City, Weiser, McCall, Idaho City, Fairfield, Lowman, Cascade, Council, Horseshoe Bend, New Meadows, Cambridge, Smiths Ferry, Ola, Banks, Garden Valley, Goodrich, Gardena, Sweet, Pioneerille and Centerville.

Turn around, don't drown when encountering flooded roads. Most flood deaths occur in vehicles.

Be aware of your surroundings and do not drive on flooded roads.

Move away from recently burned areas. Life-threatening flooding of creeks, roads and normally dry washes is likely. The heavy rains will likely trigger rockslides, mudslides and debris flows in steep terrain, especially in and around these areas.
