To All Property Owners in Gem County
2022

Notice is hereby given this spring of 2022 pursuant of the State of Idaho Noxious Weed Law
Section 22-2401, Idaho Code

It is the responsibility of all landowners to control noxious weeds on private property. If minimal or no attempt is made to control noxious weeds on private property, the Gem County Weed Department may proceed pursuant to the law to have the weeds controlled. The owner will incur the expense or it shall constitute a lien and be entered as a tax against the land to be collected as other real estate taxes are collected.
